



Patents approved and customers live in production; Keypasco had a great 2013 and 2014 is looking even better

Gothenburg, February 19, 2014 – *Keypasco has attended the RSA conference every year since the company was first launched in 2010 and we have grown tremendously and achieved great milestones during this short time.*

Examples of these great triumphs are our achievements during 2013 and early 2014:

- Today we have a global network; we are headquartered in Gothenburg, Sweden, have a second office in China, and partners in Taiwan, Brazil, China and Russia. We aim to continue to grow to offer our service around the globe.
- Our patent has so far been approved in both Taiwan and Korea, and more patents are pending. We continuously work to develop our security technology.
- The Keypasco solution has been developed to fit the market needs, and the product base has grown to offer secure multi-factor authentication and secure tasks to Internet content providers who have a large quantity of users and a need to secure them against threats like identity theft, phishing attacks, man-in-the-middle and/or man-in-the-browser attacks, or other threats. - We are also launching a new version of our back-end server Borgen. We can now offer a linear scalability, and we can guarantee a high availability (99.9%) since all cluster components are redundant. Our standard deployment supports up to 100M users and 30 000 security operations per second, but in theory there is no upper limit. We now support Windows, Mac, Linux (desktop), iOS, Android (tablet & smartphone), Chrome, Firefox, Internet Explorer, and Safari (browser).
- We have customers with 4.6M users, multiple companies interested in the solution, and new partnerships being evaluated. We look forward to what the rest of 2014 has to offer.

We aim to evolve alongside the changing nature of online authentication security. The trend on the authentication market today indicates that we are facing large changes; Offline2Online environments, how to create a secure mobile environment with no trade-off in user experience, and new threats like the EuroGrabber. When we officially launched the solution at the RSA conference in 2012 multi-factor authentication and device fingerprints were news, but since then the market has seen several new alternative authentication solutions. We see this as an acknowledgment that this market will grow and will be an important part of the future, and we are very happy that we have a head start with already approved patents and live customers.
